The Restaurant Industry has lost more than 3 MILLION JOBS and \$25 BILLION IN SALES since March 1.

A survey of 4,000 restaurant owners and operators reveals the **devastating** economic losses sustained by the industry in just 3 weeks.

THE IMPACT IN PERSPECTIVE

The industry employs 10% OF THE U.S. WORKFORCE

7 IN 10 restaurant operators have laid off employees and reduced the number of hours worked.

ROUGHLY 50% anticipate doing more of this (layoffs and hours reduction) during the next 30 days.

RESTAURANTS & OUR EMPLOYEES are suffering



88% of restaurant operators say their total dollar sales volume during the period from March 1 - 22 was lower than it was during the same period in 2019.
